

Log-in to <https://authorcentral.com> with your Amazon.com username and password.

1. Requirements are:

- a. You have an Amazon.com account.
- b. You have spent at least \$50 with Amazon in the past year.

2. Log into <https://authorcentral.amazon.com>

- a. (you will use your amazon.com login)
- b. If you have NOT published a book with Amazon or claimed authorship as a co-author – the page will be blank.

You will see profile. Click on profile – and add your bio.

Then click on books. If you are already an author, you will see your other books listed.

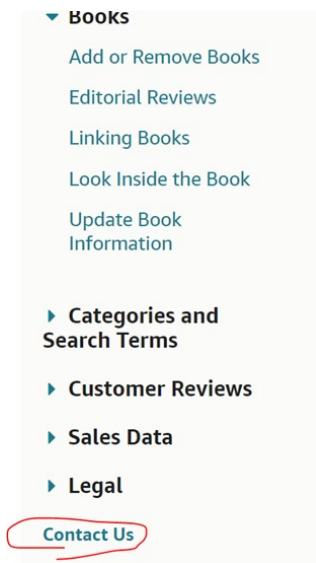

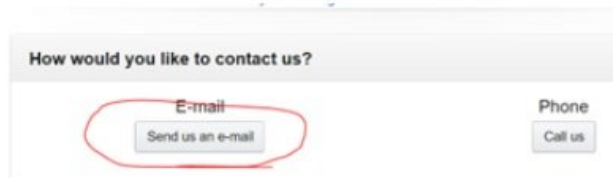
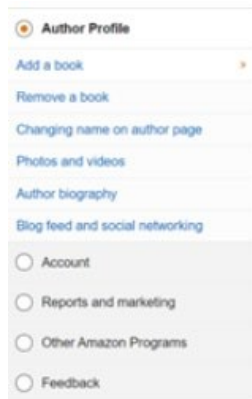

5. Sometimes for compilation books it does NOT show you as the author. In this case, you will need to submit a help ticket.
6. Click, "I'm not listed," and then Contact Us

In the email you will need to request to be added as a Co-Author. Include the title of the book, the ISBN for the paperback.

Tell them your name, the title of the chapter and the page your chapter starts on.

Usually, they respond quickly.

Once accepted add your headshot, personalize your author link, add your bio and additional images and a video (if you prefer).
